CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- Minimum of one semester of master's degree coursework completed
- Agreement that payment will be made to student's university
- Agreement to work in a school setting for one year within two years of graduation
- Agreement to complete a minimum of six weeks clinical training in a school system as part of intern/externship experience prior to graduation
- Agreement to have contact information shared with SOS as the grantor of the scholarship
- Agreement to comply with all scholarship requirements

NOMINATION PROCESS

The following items should be included in the nomination packet and submitted to the NBASLH Awards and Scholarship Committee via U.S. mail or e-mail **no later than February 15, 2012**:

- Complete the Staffing Options and Solutions application and provide the required documentation
- Current resume
- Letter indicating your intent to work in a school as a speech-language pathologist and commitment to completing at least six weeks clinical experience in a school setting prior to graduation
- Two letters of recommendation
- Letter or other acceptable documentation (such as university transcript) from your accredited university confirming that you are enrolled full-time in a master's program for speech-language pathology, speech-language-hearing sciences, communication disorders program and that you are not on academic probation in the program
- Photograph
