CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- Current or new student NBASLH member
- US Citizen
- Full-time student in an accredited master's level program in speech pathology with a concentration in the school-based pathology track
- Minimum of one semester of master's degree coursework completed
- GPA of 3.0
- Agreement that payment will be made to the student's university
- 100–250 word essay on how to effectively use technology and other resources to promote exceptional speech and language skills in a low socio-economic neighborhood in close proximity to your university
